- Database Renewal memberships

  - If a member overpays the check should be sent back to member with a note that they were already paid for the year.

  - Connie Przybyla will head committee
    - Cathy Thomas, Joan McMahon and Ginny Bowman will be part of committee
- Question: Do we want to create classes of membership?

- Complimentary members are to be moved to a separate sheet titled "Complimentary" in the main database, so they do not receive ballots or any renewal forms
